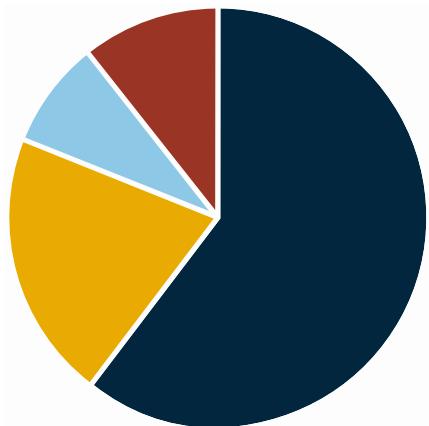
IOWA CITY

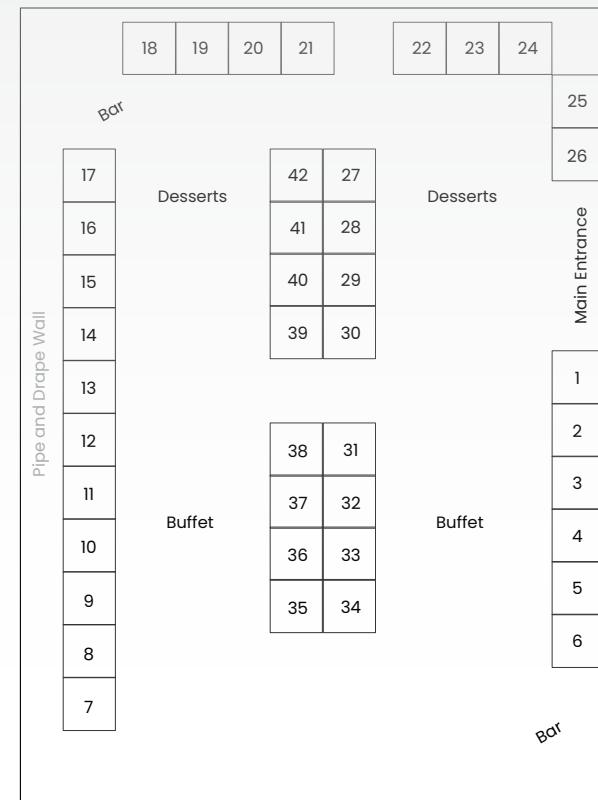
